

# Election- February 15, 2014

The Annual Election was held on February 15, 2014 at the District Fire Station, 13 Rennie Street, for the following: the election of one (1) Fire Commissioner for a term of three (3) years and the approval or disapproval of the Annual District Budget for the year 2014.

The polls were open from 2 PM to 9 PM.

The following served as the Election Board: Margaret Ayres, Gina Efaw and Dorothy Nyerges.

A total of eighteen (18) persons voted at the fire station. There was one (1) vote by mail ballot voted. The final results of the election were:
