

# Election- February 19, 2011

The Annual Election was held on February 19, 2011 at the District Fire Station, 13 Rennie Street, for the following: The election of two (2) fire commissioners for the term of three (3) years; the approval or disapproval of the Annual District Budget for the year 2011; and the approval or disapproval of a Property Tax Levy cap Referendum.

The poles were open from 2PM to 9PM.

The following served as the Election Board: Margaret Ayres, Jill Belviss, and Dorothy Nyerges.

A total of 55 persons voted at the fire station. There were 6 absentee ballots voted.

The final results of the election were:

For Fire Commissioner (three year term) -

The projected Fire District tax rate is .800 points.
