The Election of one (1) Fire Commissioner for a term of three (3) years and the approval or disapproval of the Annual District Budget for the year 2017.

The polls were open from 2 PM to 9 PM.

A total of fifty-one (51) persons voted at the fire station. There were two (2) vote by mail ballots voted and one (1) write in vote.
